It is covered with many trees around and the trees are always green in nature.

NDIPONDAN (GUINEA CORN) FESTIVAL



The Ndipondan (Guinea Corn) Festival is one of most celebrated festivals in Saboba. It is a festival celebrated to thank their ancestors for ushering them into a new farming session and granting them a good harvest. It is mostly done in March/April every year as a result, Konkombas from all walks of lives come to Chabob (Saboba) to thank their ancestors.
