SITUATIONAL REPORT:

The District Director of Education presented a detailed report of the District Education Directorate between the periods of July, 2022 to September, 2022. After the presentation the DDE moved for its acceptance, it was seconded by Mr. Jagri Mark.

Her submission was on activities carried out to promote quality education delivery in the District. She highlighted the following:

• one-day professional Development Workshop

The office organized a one-day professional Development Workshop for interested teachers by EDMAT Foundation on July 3rd 2022. 181 teachers participated in the workshop. This was made up of 100 female and 81 male teachers

• Workshop for Head Teachers and Their Assistants

It was mentioned that a two-day workshop was organized for head teachers and their assistants from 13th July-14th July 2022. 111 participants made up of 58 males and 53 females benefitted from the workshop.

• Orientation Workshop

The directorate Organized a two-day orientation workshop for 2020/2021 and 2022 newly posted teachers. 100 participants made up of 46 males and 54 females benefitted from the workshop.

• Refresher Training

The directorate organised a refresher training for master trainers on the Community Participation for Schools for all (COMPASS) Project. It was also mentioned that a six-day workshop in two Cohorts on GLOI by USAID in collaboration with MOE was organized. In all 35 participants made up of 26 teachers, 5 head teachers and 4 curriculum leads benefitted from the workshop.
