Challenges

- 1. Inadequate funds to train large number of vendors and caterers.
- 2. Difficult in bringing the team to point since some of them do not have holidays.
- 3. Difficult in convincing food vendors to come in for training.

Way forward

- 1. Periodic training of caterers and food vendors.
- 2. More funds should be made available for training in the district.
