DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Department of Social Welfare and Community Development is a decentralized department that works in collaboration with other decentralized departments and all development oriented agencies to provide social and community development services. The main goal of the Department is to assist the Assembly to formulate and implement social welfare and community development policies within the framework of national policy.

1.1 MISSION

The Department works in partnership with people in their communities to improve their well-being through promoting development with equity for the disadvantaged, vulnerable and the excluded.

1.1 VISION

The vision of the department is to take the lead in integrating the disadvantaged, the vulnerable and the excluded into the mainstream of development.

1.3.2 ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT

The Department shall

1. facilitate community-based rehabilitation of persons with disabilities (PWDs)
2. assist and facilitate provision of community care services including:
 - a) registration of PWDs;
 - b) assistance the aged;
 - c) personal social welfare services;
 - d) hospital welfare services;
 - e) assistance to street children, child survival and development; and
 - f) socio-economic and emotional stability in families;
3. assist to maintain specialized residential services in the district;
4. facilitate the registration and supervision non-governmental organization and their activities in the district;
5. assist to organize community development programmes to improve and enrich rural life through:
 - a) literacy and adult education;
 - b) voluntary contribution and communal labour for the provision of facilities and services such as water, schools, library, community centres etc and
 - c) teaching deprived or rural women in home management and child care
